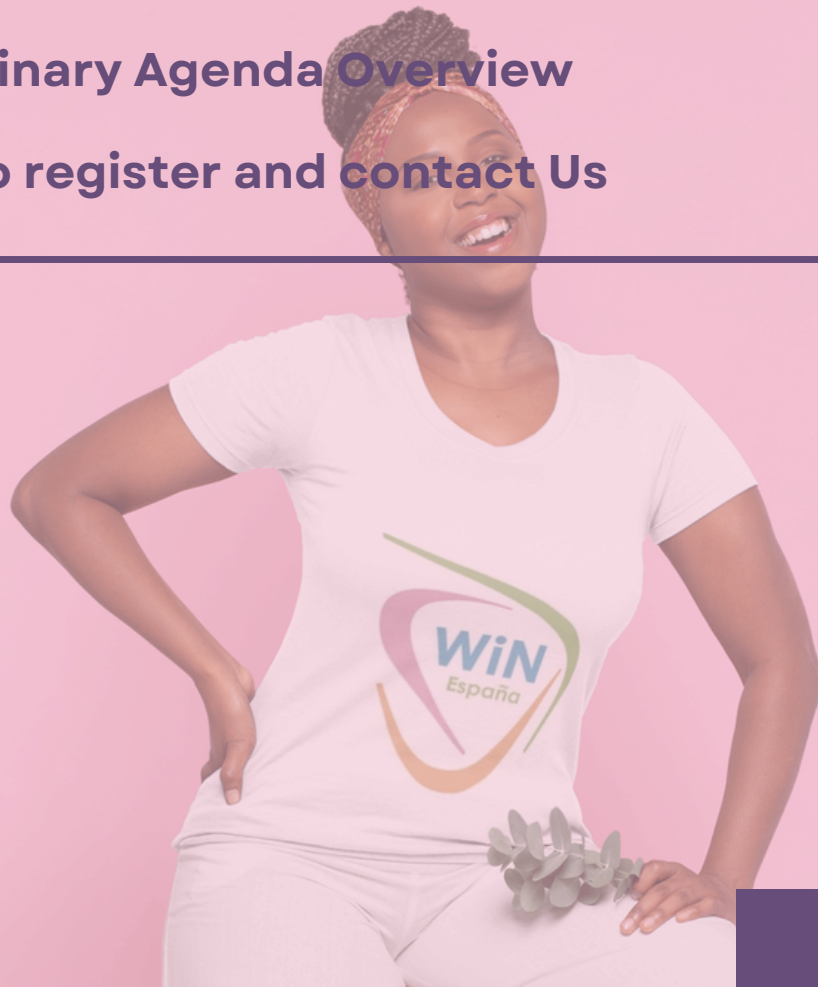

# Why Spain? Why Now?

Spain stands at a critical crossroads. It is currently the only EU country with a legally binding plan to phase out nuclear energy, despite the profound geopolitical and energy shifts that have emerged since that decision. Meanwhile, other European countries are strengthening their nuclear strategies as key pillars of their energy transitions.

This contrast between Spain's current phase-out policy and the renewed momentum for nuclear in Europe makes Madrid not just a relevant location, but the ideal place to launch a strategic conversation that the continent urgently needs.

Beyond energy, Spain is widely recognised for its strong commitment to equality, diversity, and inclusion—values at the heart of WiN Global's mission, and essential to shaping the next generation of the nuclear sector.

Hosting this first European regional event in Madrid is both timely and meaningful. It marks the beginning of a new platform, where Europe's nuclear community can:

- Reflect on shared challenges and opportunities, bringing international insight into Spain's national debate.
