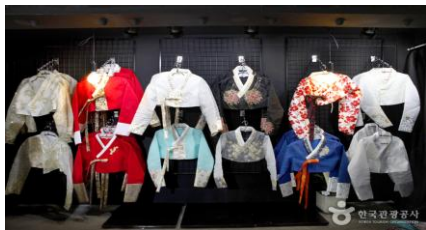

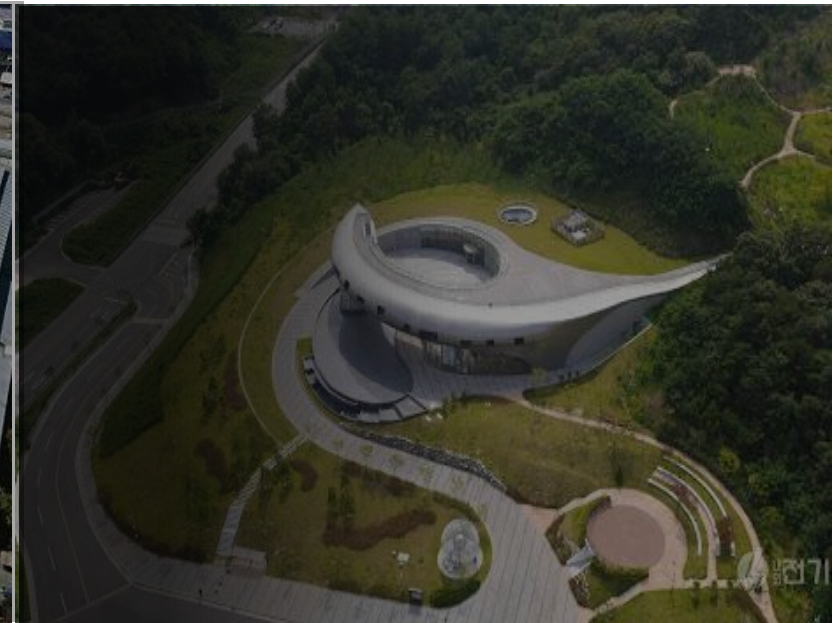

» Gyeongju is one of the most authentically Korean cities, home to UNESCO World Heritage Sites such as Bulguksa Temple, Seokguram Grotto, the Gyeongju Historic Areas, and Yangdong Village. The city also preserves 34 National Treasures and 93 Treasures of Korea. In Gyeongju, visitors can experience the historical thread of Korea — from the Silla Dynasty (BC57 ~ AD935) through Goryeo, Joseon, and into the present day.

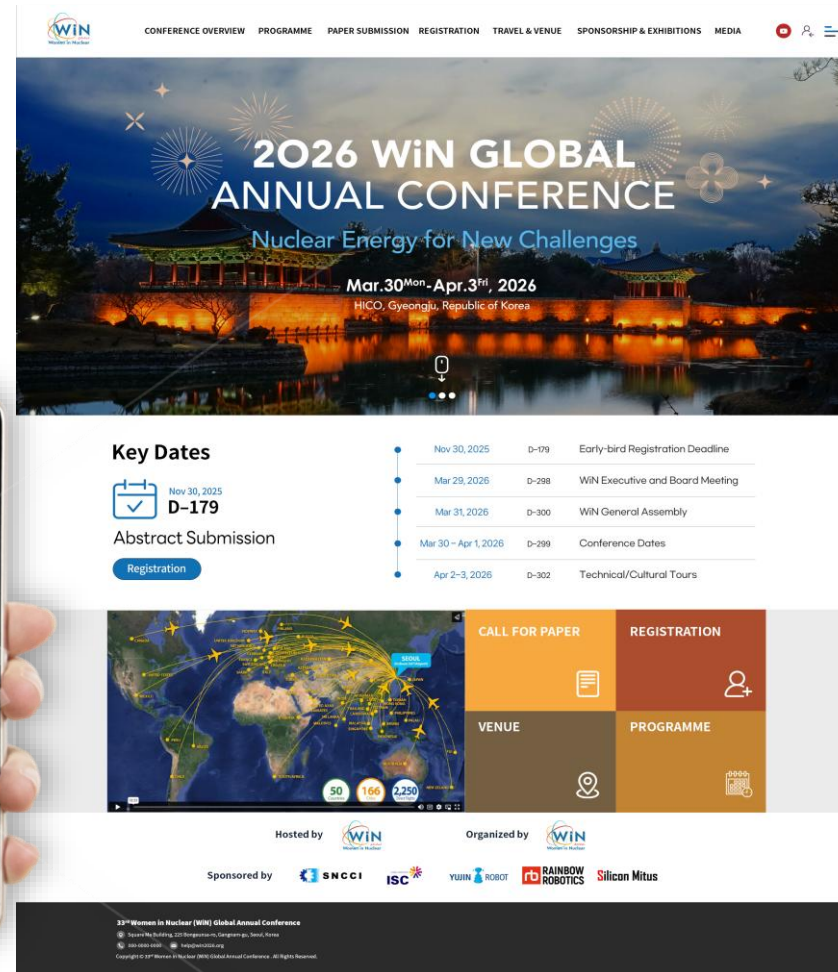
